# **Platform-supply vessels**

Our modern fleet of approximately 20 platform-supply vessels (PSV) offers deck space from 620 m2 to 850 m2 and can meet any offshore logistics requirement.

We handle liquid & dry bulks and deck cargoes in all forms and sizes, as well as pipes and project cargo. Our vessels can carry methanol and IMDG (International Maritime Dangerous Goods) class 7 materials, with safety performance and fuel efficiency being paramount. VOS operates approximately 40 emergency response and rescue vessels (ERRV), with a service that continues 24/7, 365 days/year on location.

All ERRVs boast state-of-the-art rescue equipment and rescue crafts. Operated by experienced crews, our vessels guarantee the safety of all those working on offshore installations. In addition to response-and-rescue duties, the vessels offer a range of extra services, including cargo operations, towage assistance, traffic monitoring, pollution control and general in-field support. With the main areas of operation being West of Shetlands, the North Sea and the Irish Sea Basin, our vessels and crews are skilled in performing during challenging weather conditions and can respond to any emergency situation within two minutes.
